

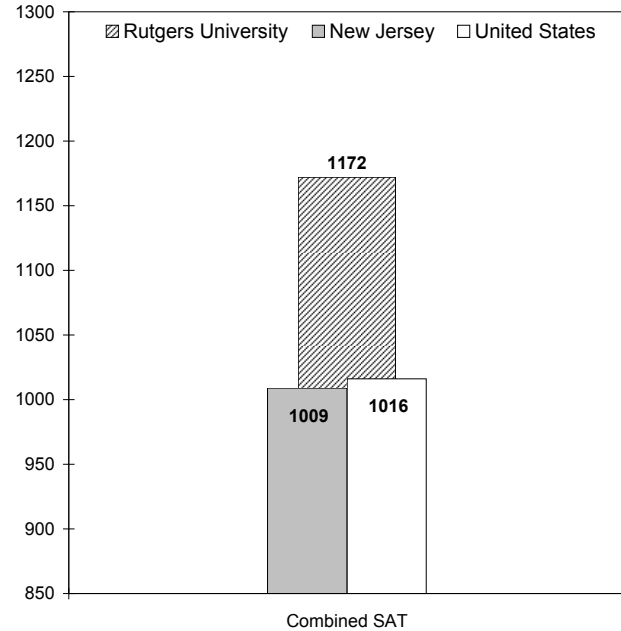
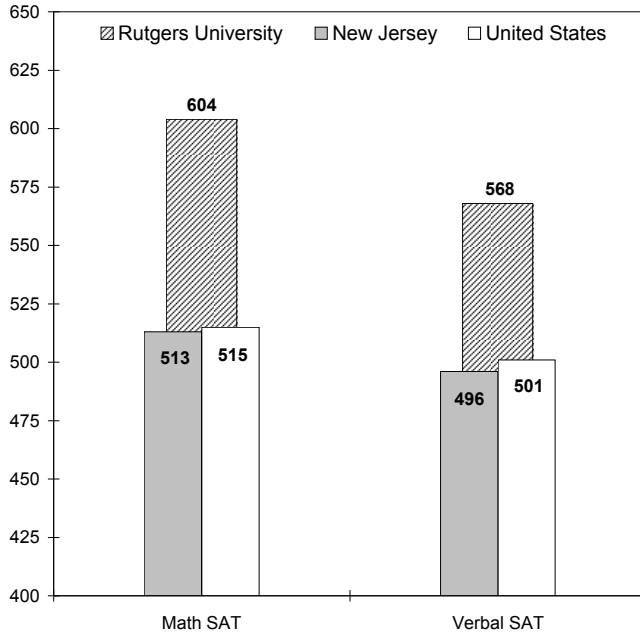

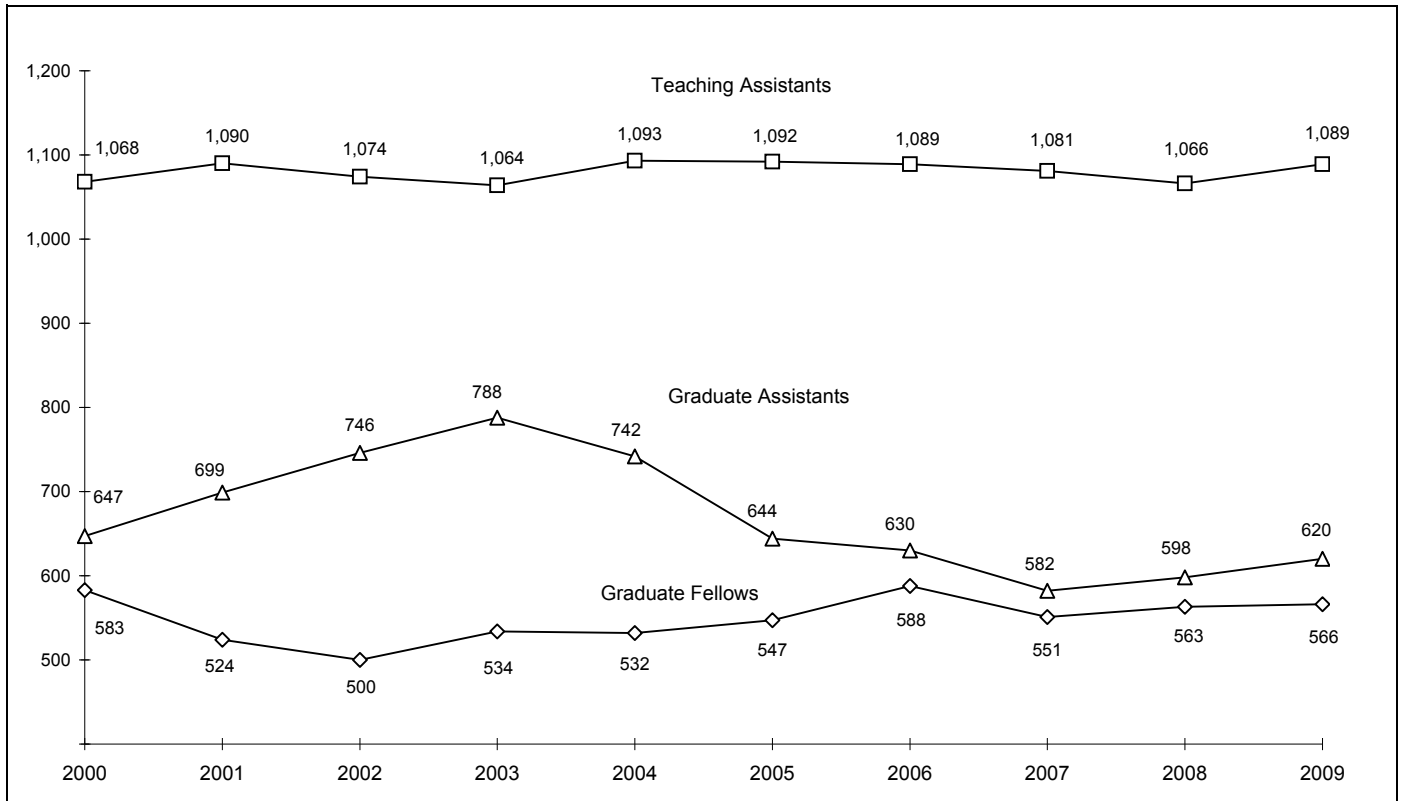

**Percent Degrees Conferred by Gender and Race/Ethnicity for Total University**

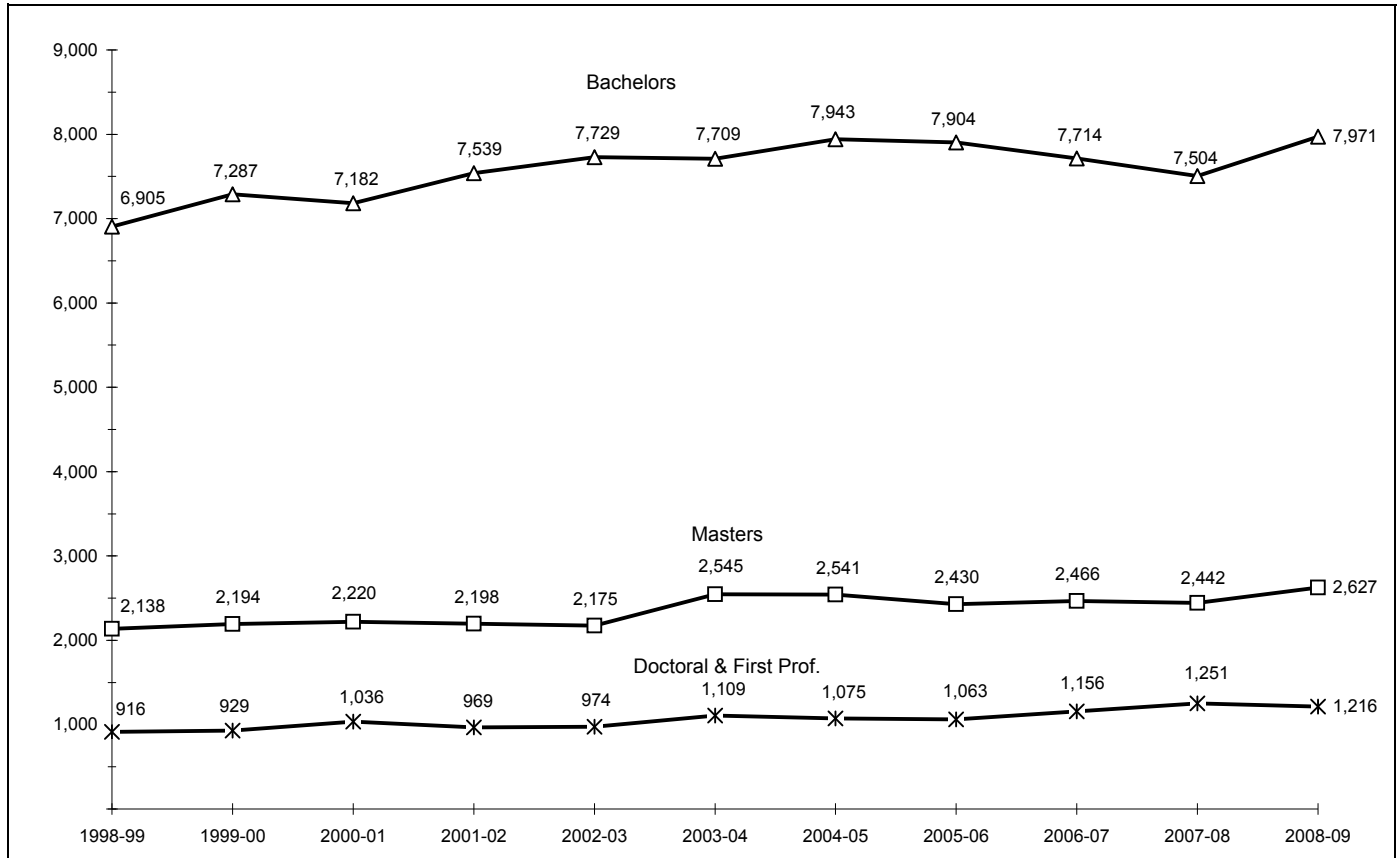

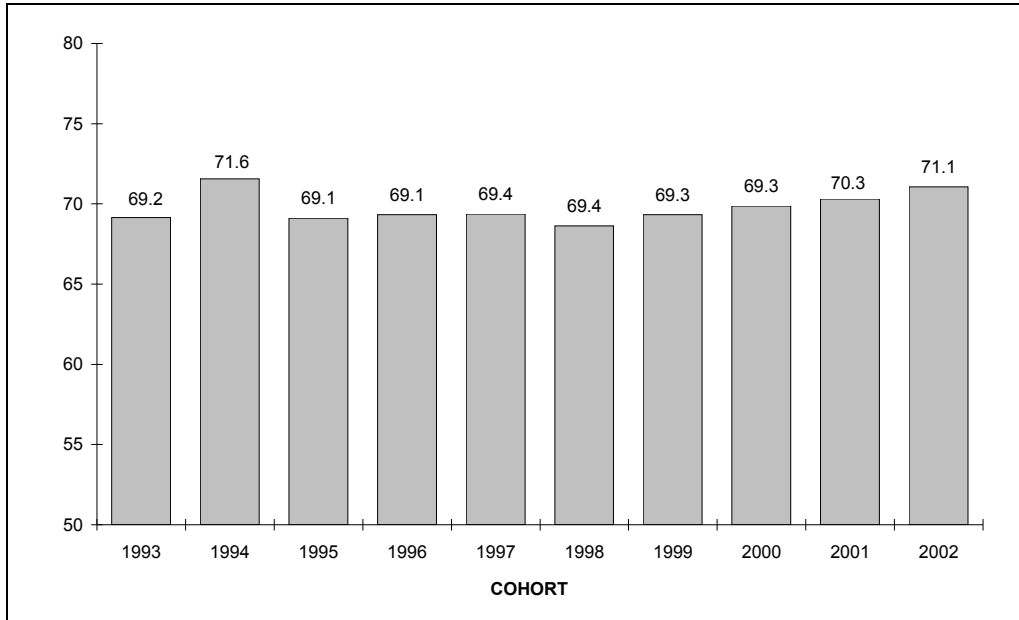
